Our purpose is to integrate those children living in familiar situations of abandonment, desertion, maladjustment, poverty or exclusion.

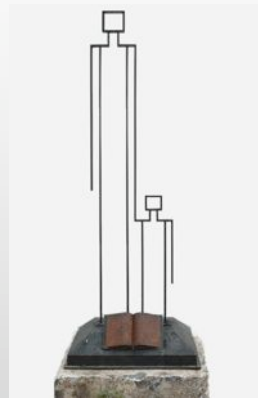


The target is an integral growth carrying out an accompaniment in a personal, social and familiar level.

We rely on the team work performed by professionals and specialists in social education.

Our Diocesan Foundation hosts sixty-six boys and girls distributed in six homes of two Residences (Orihuela y Elche) and three flats as an attempt to recreate a family environment with their educators.

We also dispose of a Day Centre for 24 children who stay here along the day and go home in the evening.



Other non residential programmes we have are:

Temporary foster care in cooperation families.

Ireneo Project, for the enrolment and follow up in the Schools.

Once these children come of age, those who do not



have the family support start an emancipation stage by means of transition flats to the adulthood.

Bearing our children's future in mind, they are trained for an immediate incorporation to the working world
